to those who meet the following criteria:**

- ◆ All 450+ residents whose homes were affected by the March 6th tornado in the Oak Grove, Grain Valley, Bates City and Odessa areas are encouraged to attend.
- ◆ Only ONE \$100 check per household will be disbursed to all in attendance (with proof of residency).
- ◆ MUST BRING ID: Current drivers license required. If your drivers license does not have your current address, then an official piece of mail: utility bill, mortgage statement, etc. can be used.
- ◆ We encourage everyone affected to come! If it is determined that you were not in the path of the storm, you will not receive funds (verifying with a master spreadsheet, Jackson County map of those affected, and Google maps)
- ◆ If a household wants to donate their \$100 check to the Community Services League to assist other families, the CSL will be present to receive those monies.
